About the Course

The music and movement education of the Orff approach includes fundamentals in rhythm, melody, orchestration, choreography, and pedagogy. Instruction will cover Orff techniques including the ostinato, pentatonic scale, simple bordun accompaniments, rhythmic and melodic training, improvisation and elemental forms as well as pedagogical concepts in teaching children. The daily program will include 3 hours of pedagogy, 80 minutes of movement, 70 minutes of recorder and 45 minutes of special topics. Upon successful completion of the course, applicants will receive the appropriate certificate.

Prerequisite: Level I is for anyone with the ability to read music that wishes to acquire basic knowledge and pedagogical foundations in the Orff Schulwerk approach. It is recommended that participants have either completed an Introduction Course or have attended many Orff workshops.

Course requirements: 100% attendance; Participation in all activities; Successful completion of all written assignments

Required materials: A list will be provided upon the receipt of the deposit. Materials will be available for purchase at the course and will cost approximately \$150.
